## **Drama Uniform**

The Drama curriculum throughout all the Key Stages comprises of both theoretical and practical work. Students are expected to come to lessons wearing clothes that are suitable for these purposes. Students will also perform in at least two exam pieces per year and for these performances the expected attire is black.

Please see below the correct exam uniform and expected wear for lessons.

### **Girls**

Lessons: School uniform trousers and shirt or comfortable trousers or shorts brought in to wear for these lessons (no skirts)

Exams: Black short sleeved or  $\frac{3}{4}$  length top (no crop or thin strapped tops)  
Black comfortable trousers, e.g. jogging bottoms (no jeans)

### **Boys**

Lessons: School Uniform

Exams: Plain Black polo cotton tops (no labels or advertising on tops)  
Plain Black comfortable trousers (no jeans)
