Arrangements For Children During Ramadan

Ramadan will begin shortly and I am writing to outline the arrangements for children within the Primary School.

For those of you new to Oman, this is a month when all Muslims will fast and therefore not eat or drink during the day. You will find that adults are asked to respect this by not eating or drinking in public during the day. Evenings tend to be very busy in and around Muscat. In addition, conservative dress is advised. Look out for further guidelines in the daily newspapers over the coming days.

The daily routine in school remains unaltered during Ramadan and all curriculum subjects continue as normal. At break time, children in Key Stage Two who are fasting go to the Primary library whilst the rest of the children go out to the playgrounds as usual. Children who are fasting are encouraged to take part in all lessons, including PE although we are sensitive to the fact that children may become tired.
