Dear Parents,

We hope you had a happy and safe summer holiday.

As you may be aware the procedure for the beginning of the day is slightly different as children move from Year One to Year Two.

When you arrive at school in the morning, we ask that Year Two children wait in the courtyard at the bottom of the main steps. To relieve congestion in this area they need to walk by their classroom on the way to leave their bags and lunchboxes by their pegs which are outside each classroom. They can hang bags on the pegs and place lunchboxes under the pegs. They do not enter the classrooms at this time.

Once they have tidily placed their belongings they wait on the courtyard. It is important to remember that this is not a playground so running around is not appropriate for the safety of all parents and children in this area.

When the bell rings they then proceed up the steps to their classroom. They collect their lunchbox and reading folders from their pegs and enter their classrooms.

It is important that no child is left alone on the playground before 7.15am. A member of staff is on duty in the courtyard area from 7.15am. It is also important that children do not enter their classroom or corridor areas before the bell rings, as staff are often involved in meetings and preparing for the day at this time.
