Clarinet Lessons

You may have noticed in the after-school activities booklet that we are introducing group flute and clarinet lessons this year.

I was intending to hold an information evening to promote these activities, however, I have already had a very good response for the flute group and this is now full. There are some spaces available in the clarinet group (which will run on a Sunday 1:40pm – 2:20pm) so if you are interested in your child taking part in this please contact me directly by Wednesday 30th September.

It would be great to have some more children learning the clarinet in the Primary School – it's a great scheme where you receive free clarinet hire for the first term and discounted lessons with Mr. Nick Foster – a professional clarinetist.

Please note that this is a fee paying activity and the terms and conditions are outlined below:

Group Clarinet Tuition Scheme Terms and Conditions

- I agree to pay the following fees a term in advance (this will usually be a 10 week term):
 - RO 8 per 40 minute session (based on 3 to 5 children in the group)
 - RO10 per 40 minute session (based on 2 children in the group)
 - RO10 per half an hour for private individual tuition
- I understand that the first term's flute rental will be free of charge but thereafter I will be liable to pay RO 15 per term and RO 10 for the summer holiday (only if required)
- Should a lesson have to be cancelled by Mr. Foster, an alternative time, or teacher will be offered. If this is not possible the cost of this lesson will be refunded
- One-off lessons missed by the student (through illness or school trip for instance) will be charged for unless 24 hours notice is given
- I understand that the relevant tuition materials are included in this price
- Fees will not be refunded should your child drop out of the group part way through the term and the clarinet is to be returned to school.
